

Installation of Opera 18 on a system which is currently running Opera 17

On a Network Windows System

(Where the License Server is installed on a server machine that may be separate from the client machine – e.g. Node Locked Network and Dongle Locked Network licenses)

Licensing Installation

Users must install *License Management Suite (LMS 2R1 and above)* with LM-X (LM-X 4.5 and above) in order to be able to use Opera 18.

On an existing system the process of installing the *License Management Suite (LMS 2R1 and above)* with LM-X (LM-X 4.5 and above) is as follows:

1. Download the *License Management Suite* from the Software Download site. Log onto the Software Download site at <http://cobham.vectorfields.com/> by entering your Customer Number, License Number and the current Access Code (this is available from your software supplier).
2. Install the *License Management Suite* on the server machine.
3. Confirmation of the licenses can be obtained from the “List Licensed Software” option in the *Opera License Utility*.

Further information can be obtained from the Opera Software Licensing Guide, which is available from the *Opera License Utility* Help facility. This information is also included in the Opera Manager User Guide, which is available from the Opera Manager Help menu.

Opera Installation

The Opera installation is a simple procedure which can be completed on all machines intending to run the software:

1. Log onto the Software Download site at <http://cobham.vectorfields.com/> and enter your Customer Number, License Number and the current Access Code (which is available from your software supplier).
2. Download Opera.
3. Follow the installation procedure:
 - Windows: Run the msi file to install Opera.
 - Linux: Follow the installation instructions on the website (Useful Links – Linux installation information).
